DESIGNED TO PERFECTION

Flanagan Lawrence, the architects of Alto, are a London-based practice. Their ability to combine inspirational design with an intuitive understanding of the ways in which real people aspire to live has earned them an enviable reputation and awards.

From the outset, they set out to give North West Village a strong overall identity that respects and enhances its location, taking care to create a balance between the landscaped areas, public spaces and building elevations.

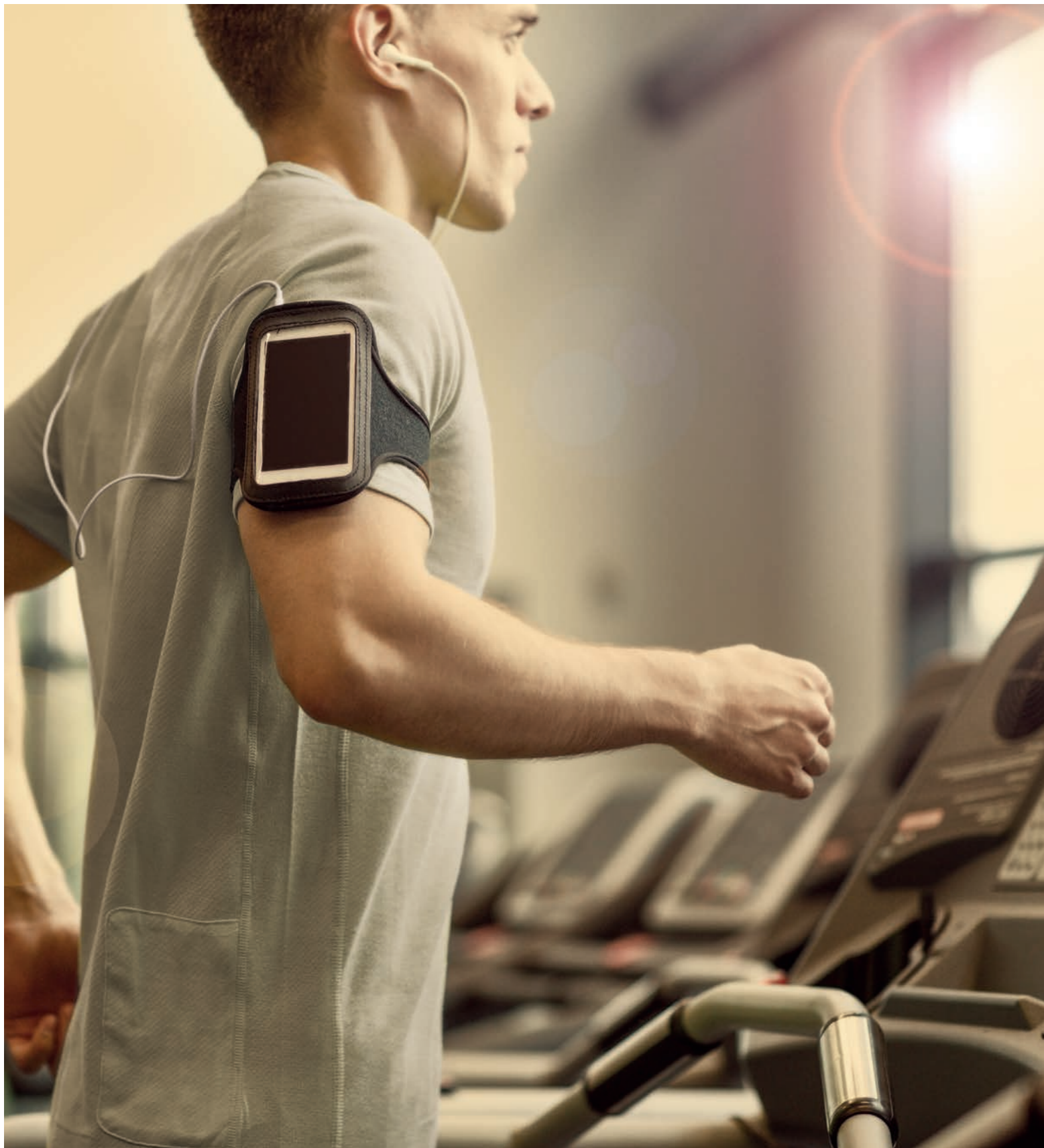

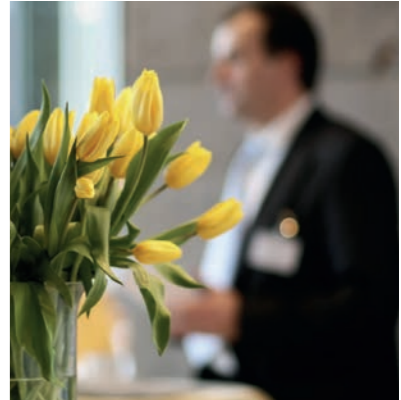

A NEW SQUARE FOR LONDON

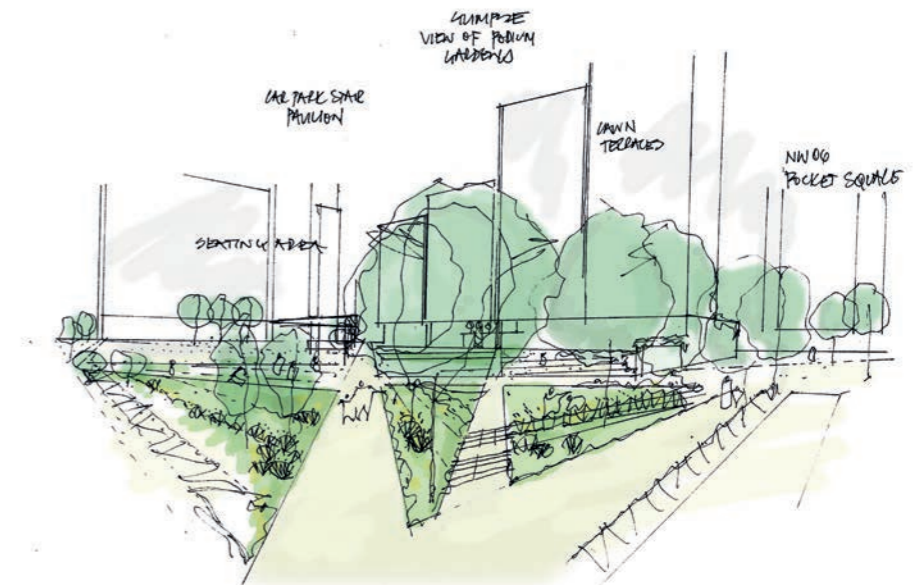
To the front of Alto, the newly landscaped Elvin Square Gardens will provide a green breathing space and a pleasant, leafy route towards Wembley Park station.

This public park takes its name from Sir Arthur Elvin, the man credited with making Wembley Park a world famous sporting venue and bringing the 1948 Olympics to the site. Its designers have created an open landscape that responds to its location offering distinct routes and generous spaces, interspersed with more intimate vistas. There's a dedicated play space for families, large expanses of lawn to maximise the sunlight and the views, and frequent seating. The park will be planted with London planes, a grove of silver birches and flowering cherry trees. 'Rain gardens' on its western edge capture storm water and enhance the scheme's biodiversity.

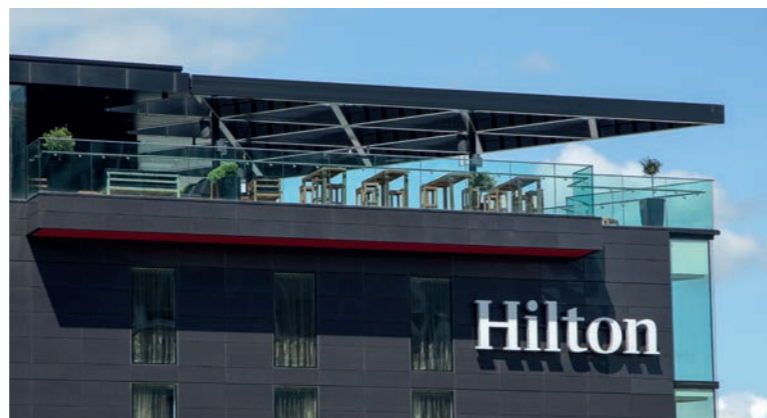

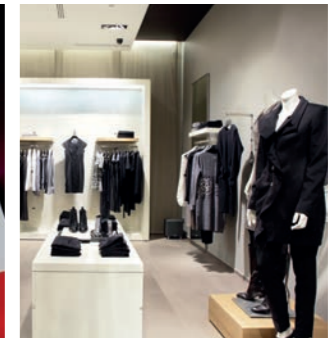

Wembley has had an indelible influence on British history since the construction of the original Wembley Stadium with its iconic twin towers. The centrepiece for the 1924-1925 British Empire Exhibition, it was opened by George V who made his first radio broadcast on the occasion. It went on to be a major venue for the 1948 Olympic Games and saw England defeat Germany in the 1966 World Cup final. And it's made more than sporting history. The stadium also played host to the 1985 Live Aid concert that electrified the world. The SSE Arena, Wembley, has also hosted major acts and artists every year since 1934.

Fiercely fought FA Cup Finals and England Internationals have focused the eyes of the entire nation on Wembley but it's far more than the hallowed home of English football.

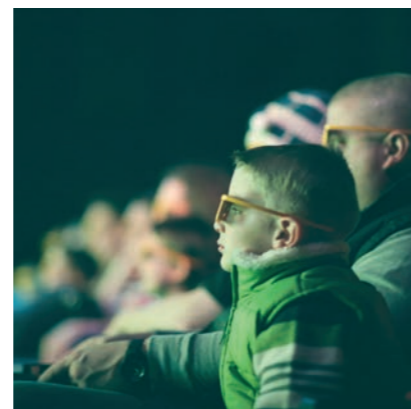

If you love sport, you're never far away from a great event. After all, Wembley Stadium and The SSE Arena, Wembley are right on your doorstep. Fancy something a bit different, though, and you'll be pleasantly surprised. There's dance and the performing arts, as showcased in the Street Dance XXL at the London Designer Outlet, destined to be an annual event after its launch last year. The local nine-screen cinema has a great programme of movies from art-house to blockbuster. And from 2016, a new purpose-built theatre to host 1300 people is due to stage a live show based on The Hunger Games.

CONNECTED ACROSS LONDON

Alto is a great place to live if you need to get somewhere fast, for work or for play. The tube, rail and road links are truly excellent, giving you easy access to the whole of London, and beyond.



The London Underground station at Wembley Park is less than a ten-minute stroll from your front door and from there, you can take the Jubilee or Metropolitan lines into the centre of the Capital. The tube will take you as far as Canary Wharf in Docklands without having to make a change.

Wembley Stadium National Rail station is equally as close, with fast non-stop links to London Marylebone and, from Wembley Central, you have access to the Bakerloo line and London Overground services.

And, if you're heading out of London, nothing could be easier. A five minute drive will take you to the A406 North Circular Road which connects smoothly to the M1, M40, M25 and the rest of the UK road network.

International travel is easy from Alto with links to London Gatwick, London Heathrow and London City Airport.

Jubilee line will be 24-hour service from September 2015.

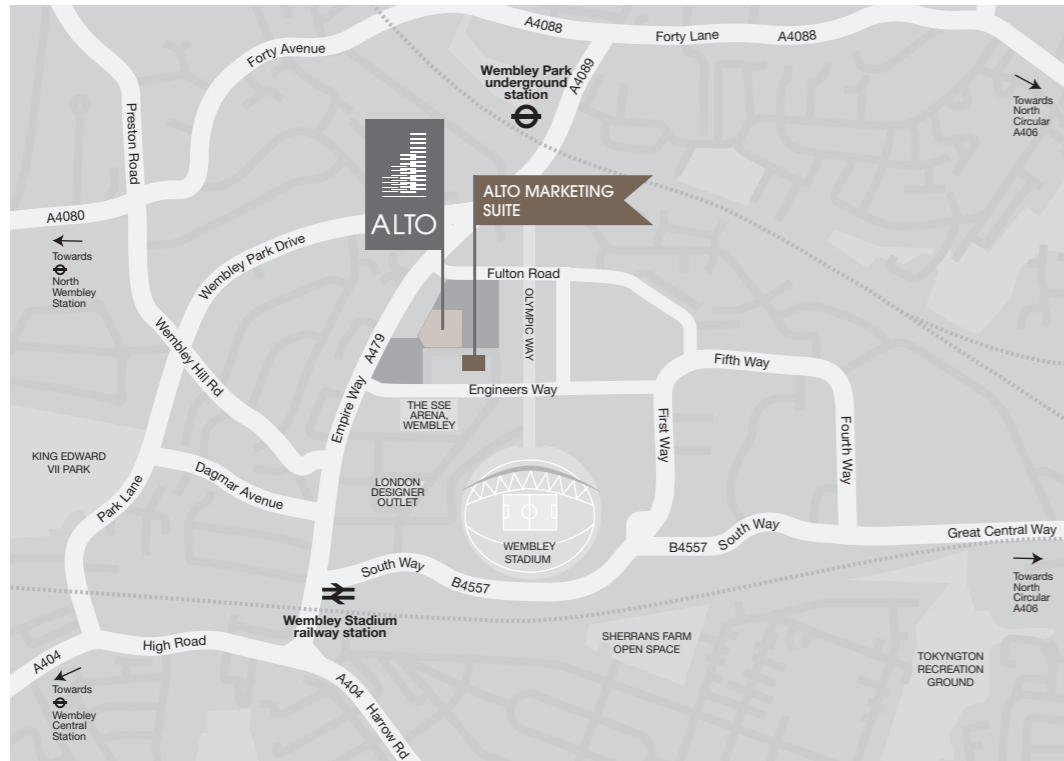
