Families will appreciate the choice of schools within a short walk or an easy drive. Those with younger children can take advantage of the new Griffin Primary school, which is located opposite the development, while Rocking Horse Kindergarten, Brownsover Community School and Boughton Leigh Junior School are all less than a mile away from Eden Park.

Older students have an excellent choice of secondary schools to choose from, all within 3 miles from Eden Park. These include The Avon Valley School & Performing Arts College, Lawrence Sherrif School (rated 'Outstanding' by Ofsted), Harris Church of England Academy, Rugby Free Secondary school and Ashlawn school. And of course Rugby School, for pupils aged 13 - 18, is one of the most famous and successful schools in the country.

Rugby has a wealth of sports and exercise amenities, including a Nuffield Health gym, the Harris Sports Centre, and the public-access Rugby School Sports Centre. Nature lovers can enjoy relaxed strolls along North Oxford Canal, Rugby's Caldecott Park, Swift Valley Nature Reserve, or nearby Draycote Water Nature & Wldlife Park.

The town has excellent transport links, so getting out and about for work and play is easy. Rugby is easily accessible from Junctions 18 & 20 of the M1 and Junction 1 of the M6. From the train station, regular services run direct to London (from 53 mins), Birmingham (from 36 mins) and throughout the country.




- 1 → Oxford Canal, Swift Valley Nature Reserve, Rugby
- (2) → Elliott's Field Shopping Centre, Rugby




