Just a short walk away from Bushby Fields you will find a Post Office, two small supermarkets, doctors' surgery, traditional pubs and a selection of independent shops. The communities of both Bushby and Thurnby can enjoy the various classes and drop-in activities on offer at Thurnby Lodge Community Centre, while Houghton & Thurnby Cricket Club is perfect for cricket fans.

A little further, but still close to home are the areas of Evington, Oadby and Humberstone which offer a wider choice of popular supermarkets, shops, banks and everyday amenities. And with the vibrant centre and benefits of Leicester just 5 miles from home, you'll have no shortage of places to go for shopping, entertainment and much more.

Based just outside Leicester city centre and less than a 15 minute drive from your new Bloor home, is the University of Leicester Botanic Garden. Designated as a Site of Special Scientific Interest, Bradgate Park boasts 850 acres of wild and unspoilt Leicestershire countryside. First enclosed as a deer park for hunting 750 years ago, today Bradgate Park is the only remaining medieval deer park in the East Midlands, where you

can still see herds of Red and Fallow Deer still roaming freely and some of the oldest rocks in England.

Enjoy and explore the great outdoors at Bradgate Park which is perfect for relaxing walks, family days out, running and cycling, whilst offering breath taking views of open countryside and woodlands. Or why not experience a tour around the ruins of Bradgate House; the childhood home and birthplace of Lady Jane Grey (the Nine Day Queen of England).

You can also visit Old John Tower – one of the Leicestershire's most famous landmarks and take a walk alongside the beautiful stretch of water, waterfalls, and pools of the River Lin. And finally, treat yourself to some locally produced cakes, a drink or an ice cream at either The Conservatory Tearoom or the Deer Barn Tearoom.
