Shadoxhurst is well connected by rail with frequent services between Ashford and London Waterloo, London Bridge and via High Speed to St Pancras International. Equally, Ashford International could see you sipping champagne at the Eiffel Tower or attending a business meeting in just a couple of hours. There is also a regular bus service between Ashford and Tenterden that passes through Shadoxhurst.

By road, junction 10 of the M20 is just over six miles away, approximately 15 minutes drive, connecting you with Folkestone and Dover to the south and Maidstone and beyond to the north.

The King's Head is Shadoxhurst's own award winning pub, which is the hub of the community. It also has a stunning 13th century church, which caters for pastoral needs.

Shadoxhurst is a little over six miles south west of Ashford, a bustling town with international rail links and a designer outlet village for the fashionably minded. Alternatively, there are a plethora of country houses, castles, gardens and other unique venues to visit including:

**Bodiam Castle** is a superb 14th century castle set in the heart of an historic landscape and is one of Britain's most picturesque and romantic ancient monuments.

Bedgebury National Pinetum and Forest offers some of the best walking, cycling, mountain biking, horse riding, adventure play and orienteering for people of all ages and abilities. Or just walk through parkland, beside lakes and enjoy the world's finest collection of conifers.

Leeds Castle is set in 500 acres of beautiful parkland where you can journey through 900 years of captivating history. From a Norman stronghold; a medieval royal home; a palace used by Henry VIII; a Jacobean country house; a Georgian mansion; an elegant early 20th century retreat; and now one of the most visited historic buildings in Britain.



Sissinghurst Castle has a diverse history; from a prison in the 1700s, a home to the women's land army to a family home to some fascinating people. Today you can take in the ruined architecture of the extensive original buildings, panoramic views from the top of the Tower, the working farm and the 450-acre estate along with the world-renowned gardens.

Buckmore Park Kart Circuit where you can experience the thrill of real outdoor karting. Follow in the footsteps of F1 drivers Lewis Hamilton and Jenson Button – both of whom learnt their trade here as youngsters. From 6 mph kids karts to 80 mph adult sports karts, there's something for everyone.

The Romney, Hythe and Dymchurch Railway is the world's smallest public railway, with the most complete collection of one-third full size steam locomotives in the world. Travel from Hythe to Dungeness or just visit the model railway exhibition; it's a great way to spend time with kids and family.



Travelling on the M20 exit the motorway at junction 9, at the roundabout take the Ashford, Canterbury, Tenterden (A20) exit, at the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit towards Tenterden, Great Chart onto Templar Way (A28). Stay on the A28 (over the next three roundabouts) until you see the Shadoxhurst, Kingsnorth signpost on your left hand side, turn into Chilmington Green Road. Continue past Criol Lane, until you reach Tally Ho Road, turn right into Tally Ho Road, this road will become Woodchurch Road. As you enter Shadoxhurst, you will see the Kings Head pub on your left hand side, Oak Fields is about 125m beyond, on your right hand side.
