### THE OPENING SCENE

It's Wood Street, Walthamstow, 1910.
The hub of the Walthamstow film industry which sprang to life in the first few decades of the 20th Century.

Studios including Precision, Broadwest and Cunard made their home in the Walthamstow suburbs to stop the smog of central London appearing in their films. Nearly 400 silent movies were made here in less than 20 years.

The studios found extras for their films in the pub which is still here on Wood Street. Today's Wood Street Indoor Market, used to be the site of the Penny Picture Theatre company. Today the market is filled with over 30 quirky market traders selling vintage fashion, vinyl, jewellery, mind, body and soul goods, and gifts.



#### **A SILENT START**



Few people know about
Walthamstow's film making history.
Nothing remains of the studios,
though copies of some of the films
can be viewed at the British Film
Institute. Wonderful old pictures can
be found on microfilm, in rare books
and inside local newspapers dating
back nearly 100 years.

On 1 May 2017, the actor Paul McGan, who's something of a silent film fan, unveiled a special blue plaque to mark the site of the Precision studios. More plaques are to follow, marking the site of all the others.







The Vestry House Museum, Walthamstow, houses a photographic archive containing publicity photos and 'stills' taken on the film sets.






#### SCENE 2 THE CLOSE UP




### FINDING FEATURE 17

Feature 17 is only half a mile from Walthamstow town centre and is served by Wood Street train station, connecting to London Liverpool Street, and Walthamstow Central, with its extensive train, underground and bus links. The area is bordered to the north by Chingford and to the south by Leyton and Leytonstoe. Central London is only 7.5 miles away and the area also benefits from the A406 North Circular and M11 being close by.




